Wildlife Clubs Bylaws No. 1

Rules of Behavior in Wildlife Clubs

These Bylaws have been drafted by the wildlife clubs committee on 2nd May 2000. The purpose is to ensure that WildLife Clubs are maintained at a level that is acceptable to all Members and in line with the WildLife Clubs of Seychelles Constitution and to the laws of Seychelles.

All Leaders and Members of WildLife Clubs must understand they have certain responsibilities to maintain acceptable standards and behavior in any situation where they are representing WildLife Clubs and in any event organized by WildLife Clubs. In particular the good name of WildLife Clubs must be upheld at all times. The following list contains of internal rules of behavior, which must be observed.

- A) Do not use illegal drugs and controlled substances during any WildLife Clubs activities.
- B) Do not use alcohol during any WildLife Clubs activities.
- C) When on field trips, do not make unauthorised use of telephone, houses and equipment, including boats and computers.
- D) Do not take/ remove/ transfer WildLife Clubs property without authorisation.
- E) Do not take, harm, and sell any endangered and protected biodiversity.
- F) Do not be involved in unauthorised transactions of foreign exchange/ currency during any Wildlife Clubs activities.
- G) Do not retain for your own benefit, any revenues gathered from services and sales offered under the name of Wildlife Clubs.
- H) During any Wildlife Clubs activities, do not interfere with the work of Leaders or other members and do not physically, verbally or otherwise abuse leaders, members, students, staff and members of the public present.
- I) Do not speak ill about Wildlife Clubs.

Failure to adhere by these rules and regulations may provide sufficient grounds for the Wildlife clubs committee to expel any leaders/members under Article 8.5 of the wildlife clubs constitution. Any complaint referring to the above rules by any leader, member of the committee or member of the public will be investigated by the committee and appropriate action taken.
